**CCV SUMMER GAMES 2012
VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT
RULES & REGULATIONS**

The following rules and regulations pertain to the Corporate Champions Vancouver Summer Games 2012 Volleyball Tournament. All rules and regulations are subject to change.

Section A – Registration

- I. Team Roster Forms must be submitted online by May 19th, 2012. Team Roster Forms are available online. Teams must register a minimum of 7 players and can register a maximum of 12 players.
- II. Each participant **MUST** sign a waiver form prior to playing and must check in with photo ID before each match. Waiver forms are available online or at the event in paper form.

Section B – Venue

- I. All Volleyball games will take place at the Richmond Olympic Oval.
- II. Participants are to abide by the rules and regulations of the Richmond Olympic Oval while on-site.

Section C – Tournament Structure

Note: A tournament schedule will be sent out to team coordinators and also posted online closer to the date of the tournament.

- I. A five minute leniency will be given to all late teams. After the five minutes has expired, the late team will be deemed to have forfeited the match. Please arrive early for warm-up time.
- II. In round robin, teams will play each opponent in their pool once. Pools will likely consist of 4 teams.
- III. Following round robin games, teams will be divided into two playoff tiers: Tier 1 and Tier 2.
- IV. The top two teams from each pool based on wins and then point differentials will advance to Tier 1 Playoffs while the remaining teams advance to Tier 2 Playoffs.
- V. In the playoffs, a single elimination tournament bracket will be used.

Section D – Game Structure

- I. Games are played six-on-six.
- II. There must be at least two members of the opposite on the court at all times so that the gender ratio is either 2:4 or 3:3. There are **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this rule and breach of the rule will result in disqualification.
- III. Matches will consist of a best of three sets: 25-25-15. A team must win by two points. The first two sets are capped at 27 points and the third set is capped at 17 points. There may be an exception to the cap rule in the playoffs. (If time permits, teams may play out the sets until a win by two points.)
- IV. There is a time limit of 40 minutes for each match.
- V. Each team can call one thirty-second time out per set.
- VI. Scoring will be based on the rally point system where each service results in a point.
- VII. All games are self-officiated. Please remember to show sportsmanship.
- VIII. The net will be set to Junior Boys height.



Section E – Tie Breakers

- I. Should teams be tied in points when determining playoff positions the following tie breaker applies: i) head to head record; ii) points differential; iii) fewest points against; and then iv) most points for.

Section F – Equipment

- I. Game balls will be provided.
- II. All players **MUST** wear indoor shoes or running shoes.

Section G – Rules

- I. All ceilings and obstacles are out of play unless otherwise specified.
- II. Substitutions can be rotated into the game in the service position. There is no limit to the number of substitutions. All substitutions must be made at the stoppage of play.
- III. Ball warm-ups will **NOT** be allowed if another game is in progress on the adjacent court.
- IV. Players should not step into the adjacent court at any time.
- V. The service can be overhand or underhand and servers will have one 8-second attempt.
- VI. Setting is allowed on a served ball.
- VII. Those players playing in the back row can only make a vertical jump if they take off from behind the attack line (3 metre line), both on offense and defense.

Section H – CCV Fair Play

- I. The event coordinators have the authority to remove any player or team from the premises for unsportsmanlike conduct.
- II. Please adhere to the general principles of Corporate Champions Vancouver Fair Play:
 - a. Follow the rules; Respect your team and opponents; and Represent your company in a professional manner.
- III. When the general principles are violated, the Corporate Champions Vancouver organizing team reserves the right to disqualify, suspend, remove and sanction coaches, players, spectators and or companies before, during or after competition. All incidents will be reported to Company Coordinators.

Section I – Team Cancellations

- I. Cancellations must be in writing either emailed or faxed to the Corporate Champions Vancouver office.

If a team must cancel their participation in a sport, the Penalties are as follows:

 - **CANCELLATIONS: Notification given after May 19, 2012.**
All cancellations after this date will result in a ten (10) point deduction of the overall points score.
 - **LAST MINUTE CANCELLATION: Notification given within 48 hours of match.**



All cancellations made within 48 hours before the start of the match will result in a twenty (20) point deduction of the overall company points score.

- **MISSING A GAME: No notification given**

If a company misses two (2) matches during the round robin the team will be considered a Cancellation or No Show and a thirty (30) point deduction of the overall company points score be applied.

If you are aware that your team cannot make a match, please inform the Corporate Champions team so your opponents are made aware of the situation.

Section J – Medals and Awards

- I. A maximum of twelve medals will be awarded to each winning team.
